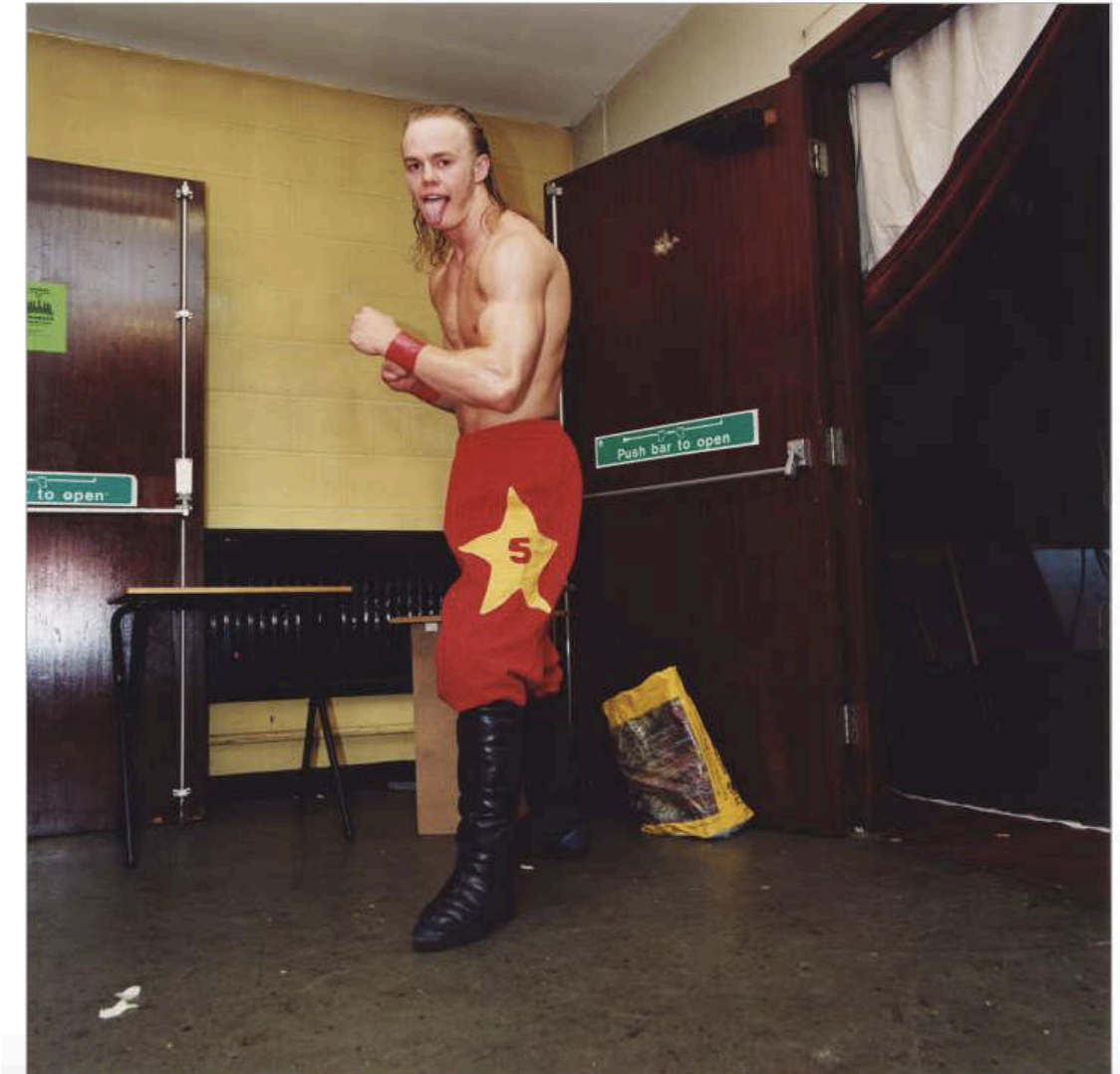
describe your self It's a nice 300-350 with a black cross on it
